

Annual ICD-10 CM Updates

R05, cough, is now invalid. You likely have a cough template that you will need to update with a new primary diagnosis code. You can find the following updated codes when you search the complete list within OP.

- R05.1 Cough, acute
- R05.2 Subacute cough
- R05.3 Cough, chronic
- R05.8 Cough, other specified
- R05.9 Cough, unspecified

F32.9, Major depressive disorder, single episode, unspecified is now replaced with F32.A depression, unspecified. If you have a depression template, it would be a good idea to make sure you don't have F32.9 assigned to it. Since ICD-10 CM previously lacked an unspecified depression code, this was often used as the best option.

P09, Abnormal findings on neonatal screening, is now invalid, and the group has been expanded to include:

- P09.1 Abnormal findings on neonatal screening for inborn errors of metabolism
- P09.2 Abnormal findings on neonatal screening for congenital endocrine disease
- P09.3 Abnormal findings on neonatal screening for congenital hematologic disorders
- P09.4 Abnormal findings on neonatal screening for cystic fibrosis
- P09.5 Abnormal findings on neonatal screening for critical congenital heart disease
- P09.6 Abnormal findings on neonatal screening for neonatal hearing loss
- P09.8 Other abnormal findings on neonatal screening
- P09.9 Abnormal findings on neonatal screening, unspecified

This should cover most of the significant changes you will encounter, but the complete list of updates can be found here.

At the top of the Encounter template Editor within OP, you will find a Validate Dx button. This will show you all of your templates that have invalid diagnosis codes associated with them.
